

Across the globe, there have been many “limited or special editions” of MX-5. Here are some details on cars introduced into the Australian market in the NA series.



NA6 Neo Green Limited Edition (1990)

This was the first of many Limited Editions (“LEs”) that have run across all variants of the MX-5.

In Australia (this car was also released in other countries) the car consisted of the following features:

- Each car uniquely numbered as part of total 300 cars for Australia
- All cars were painted *Neo Green* (a nod to British Racing Green) – exclusive to the LE only
- Tan interior with leather seats
- Tan tonneau to cover folded down roof
- CD player
- Speakers in seat headrests
- Colour-keyed removable hard top
- Factory air conditioning
- Door sill scuff plates – chrome and wider than normal
- Various interior trim items to hide fixings etc.
- Protein protective coating to dash board
- Numbered (xxx of 300) Momo wooden gear knob
- Retained manually-operated side mirrors



1992 – Special Edition

- NA6 cars offered in *Sunburst Yellow* with black interior
- 60 cars bought into Australia, January 1992
- CD player and headrest speakers
- Remote boot release
